As a charitable nonprofit organization, Friends of the Montecito Library works to ensure that our library's doors will stay open, providing access to books and media, enrichment programs, free internet access, and most of all, a welcoming smile.

However, costs continue to rise and governmental resources cannot be depended on to keep the doors open. Our library needs you now more than ever. Your tax-deductible donations to the Friends of the Montecito Library have provided up to half of the Montecito Library's operating costs.

In July 2020, opened **sidewalk service** offering access to materials and human connection



Grant-funded **Community Read** programs for Montecito and Summerland, including in-person and virtual book clubs and author talks. Grant money was used to purchase 200 copies of book from local community bookstore, Tecolote, and are given to patrons for free
